



## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By entering this competition you agree to the following:

- On signing this form the member declares the horse(s) on this form plus any other horse(s) on the property of origin have no clinical evidence of Equine Influenza during the last 14 days;
- Riders will comply with DPI&F and RASDEG Biosecurity requirements and contingency plan in case of EI outbreak during the event;
- Entry will not be accepted if the 2008 disclaimer has not been signed and included with your membership or if insufficient money is enclosed: it will be returned;
- You must be a current financial member of RASEG Inc. otherwise entry will be refused;
- No telephone, fax or email entries will be accepted;
- Riders who are under the age of 18, must be under the direct supervision of their parent/ guardian at all times;
- Current ASA Helmet must be worn at all times while mounted on a horse, including warm up and parking areas. You may be required to provide proof your helmet is current AS/NZS 3838: 1998;
- It is the competitor's responsibility to present to gear check before each test;
- Event run under EFA rules;
- Maximum 3 tests at 2 consecutive levels (dressage tests);
- Callers are permitted however competitors must make their own arrangements. RASDEG officials are not responsible for the organisation of callers;
- No canteen facilities, however cold drinks will be for sale on the day;
- No dogs allowed on the grounds;
- RASDEG members will be allocated a job for the day as the day will be "rider run";
- No refund after closing date unless vet/doctors certificate supplied within 1 week of the event (30% will be retained for administration expenses);
- If the event is cancelled RASDEG may retain an administration fee to cover costs incurred;
- Protests to be lodged with the appeal committee in writing and accompanied by \$100, not later than ½ hour after the incident that gave rise to the protest;
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure all equipment meets EFA & safety regulations. If a competitor's conduct or equipment in anyway compromises the safety of others, entry will be refused;
- As per EFA rules, no electronic or rope yards are permitted at any RASDEG competition.

Neither the Organising Committee of any competition to which these rules apply nor the EFA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
